Remembering Dr. George Boone


Last August we lost one of our distinguished colleagues and friends, Dr. George Boone.

George was a Pasadena orthodontist who graduated from USC Dental School, was trained under Dr. Spencer Atkinson and Dr. Cecil Steiner. George taught with Spencer Atkinson and, along with a group of Cecil Steiner's study club members, then joined Harry Dougherty in 1960 to teach in the new USC graduate orthodontic program.

George maintained a private practice, first in Los Angeles and later in Pasadena. George was a Diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics and a full member of the Edward H. Angle Society. He was well known for finishing great cases, attention to detail was his forte. In the late 60's George began to develop cataracts, which at the time were not 100% treatable. His vision and, specifically, depth perception were impaired. Regretfully he was forced to change his occupation. George became a real estate

investor using his superb business acumen, and ambitious work ethic. He focused on the Santa Fe Springs area in industrial real estate. His projects have always been known for their attractive flair and attention to detail.

George continued to be involved at USC, still teaching in graduate orthodontics, bringing in important consultants to teach the residents how to run their future small businesses. George was president of the USC general alumni association and then became a lifetime member of the USC Board of Trustees. Even though Dr. Boone had many responsibilities to the USC Board of Trustees, he continued to be involved in the dental school. He was also generous enough to provide matching funds that made our move to the third floor facility possible. George later became involved with the USC Wrigley marine biology center on Catalina Island. His vision and hard work created a world class Italian villa retreat in the solitude of Twin



Harbors. It is a retreat that is unique both in style and location and will provide a meeting place for many important future USC decisions.

George was a wonderful man who loved his family and gave to his community and to his school. Even though his life moved away from the dental profession, he always was a dear friend to the dental school and especially graduate orthodontics. He will be greatly missed.
